### 1 - 2 Week Courses (Monday to Friday)

Designed for beginners and all levels of skill.

Create a finished work in this time.

- Monday Demonstration of stone carving techniques using traditional hand tools / skills. Selection of Stone. Establishing starting points and individual ideas for carving.
- Tuesday to Friday Individual Tuition Develop carving skills as the week progresses, from
   roughing out, to fine detail and finishing techniques for
   Portland Stone.
- Friday afternoon Discussion on work.
   Pointers for the future, options for training.
   Photographing work and loading into vehicles to take home.
- 4 Weeks Course as above allows for in depth tuition and development of skills in direct carving, 3D sculpture and relief carving. Or develop a series of works that develop skills in stone masonry, lettercutting and architectural detail.

The course fee includes professional tuition, use of hand carving tools and open-air or indoor workspace. There is an additional cost for Safety Glasses and if needed and use of powered equipment (including lifting equipment and stone saw) to cover set up time, running costs and consumables. The course fee does not include travel, personal medical insurance or accommodation.
